Our goal is to send 750 boxes this year at a cost of \$10 per box, which means we need \$7,500 to cover shipping. Last year our goal was 700 and thanks to the Lord, we exceeded our goal. We are also in need of more supplies. If you have items at home, please bring them and place them in the box by the lobby bathrooms by next Sunday, October 9, so we can have an accurate count. Consider donating the following:
