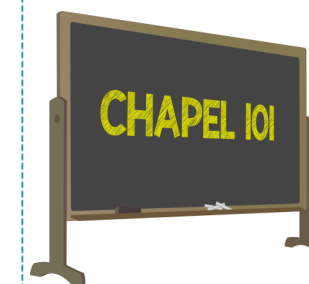
The Youth will serve at Amy's House of Hope today at 3:00 p.m. Contact Pastor James with any questions.
