- ENVELOPES LOCATED IN THE BACK OF THE PEW These unnumbered envelopes must include your name and the amount of the gift on the front of each envelope if you want to have a record kept.

  - Mission Offering: All gifts placed in a Mission Offering envelope will go toward that month's Mission Offering, which we announce early in the month.


