- **NOTICE REGARDING 2025 CONTRIBUTIONS** - In order for your contributions to be tax-deductible in 2025, they must be postmarked or delivered to the church by Wednesday, December 31. **Thank you for your faithful support of this ministry.**
- **OFFERING ENVELOPES** - Please pick up a complete box of numbered envelopes (not individual envelopes) at the Information Center if you want the church to keep a record of your gifts placed in the offering plate. If you still have numbered envelopes from 2025, you may continue to use them during 2026. If you pick up a new box, please be sure to write your name and the amount of your gift on the front of the envelope so we will know to change your envelope number.
- **ENVELOPES LOCATED IN THE BACK OF THE PEW** - These unnumbered envelopes must include your name and the amount of the gift on the front of each envelope if you want to have a record kept.
 - **Building Fund:** Use this envelope any time during the year that you wish to contribute toward our Building Fund.
 - **Mission Offering:** All gifts placed in a Mission Offering envelope will go toward that month's Mission Offering, which we announce early in the month.
 - **Special Offering:** Use this envelope for special projects announced during the year, such as the Benevolent Fund, Operation Christmas Child, etc. Please write the project name on the envelope. *Undesignated envelopes will go to the General Fund.*
- **E-GIVING SERVICE*** - E-Giving is designed to enable you to contribute online and transfer funds electronically from your checking or savings account or by credit or debit card. E-Giving will provide the same level of confidentiality to which you are accustomed, plus the convenience that online services offer.
