SECURITY UPDATE - Beginning on Sunday, February 1, the hallway door leading into the nursery suite will be locked during church services to aid in the safety of our babies and toddlers while they are in our care. The door will be open before service for drop off and after for parent pickup. Should you need to enter during the service time, a safety team member will be present to allow parent access. There is also a buzzer to alert the nursery volunteers if you should wish to enter. Additionally, we ask that only those picking up children enter the nursery hall area. Family and friends may gather in the main lobby and join parents there. Exiting the building through the main doors also helps keep our nursery more secure. 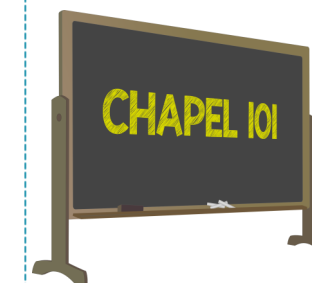
