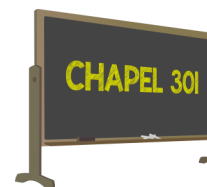

MINISTRY FOCUS



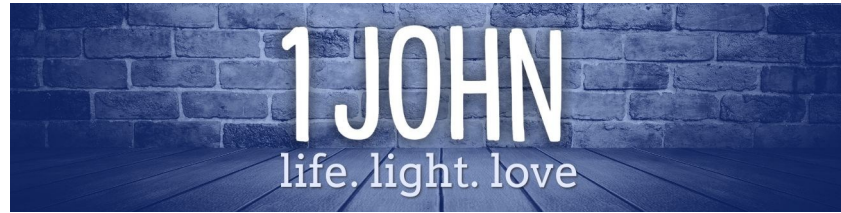
